Dr. Dimitris P. Sotiropoulos

Dimitris P. Sotiropoulos was born in Athens, 1972 and is a Professor of Contemporary Political History at the University of Peloponnese, as well as the Vice Director of the MPA, “Public Administration and Local Government”. He is also President of the Department, “Administrative Science & Technology”.

Previously, he taught for 8 years at the Ionian University, and more recently at the National School of Public Administration and the Hellenic Open University.

He is a member of the NEW HESTIA’s journal editorial team, and is a regular columnist of the KATHIMERINI newspaper as well as of the LIFO magazine.

He is a member of the Scientific Committees of the “Philosophein Journal” and of the “Foreign Affairs, The Hellenic Edition”. He is also a Scientific Committee of the "Angelos Delivorias" Circle member (Hellenic American Union) as well as a member of the "Historical Studies Society of Cyprus". He is the editor of the "Ideas and Politics" series at the publishing house, Metaihmio.

More recently, he wrote the essays, "Phases and Contradictions of the Greek State in the 20th Century, 1910-2001" (Hestia, Oct. 2019) and the "From Anendotos to PASOK period"(May 2019) in the series "National Crises" of KATHIMERINI’s editions. Finally, he was the editor of nine collective volumes, including the English, “Political and Cultural Aspects of Greek Exoticism (Palgrave-Macmillan, July 2019), with P. Panagiotopoulos and has more than 70 publications in scientific journals and collective volumes.

He is also a radio producer, for @Amagi Radio, presenting a show once a week, under the title, “Stories from the first floor”.
